REGULATIONS for the XXX All-Ukrainian

Ivan Pryshchepa Memorial Judo Tournament

1. Aims and Purposes

- popularizing judo amongst the youth;
- improving sports performance in young athletes;
- commemorating the memory of the first chairman of Ivan Pryshchepa Judo and Sambo Federation of Dnipro Region;
- strengthening friendly ties between athletes from different countries.

2. Time and Venue

The competition is held on March 23-24, 2018 at Sports Complex «Olympia+», 12B Arzhanova Str, Dnipro.

The teams arrive on March 23, 2018. The training sessions are scheduled on March 25-26, 2018 at Sports School No. 6 at 36-D Slobozhansky Avenue, Dnipro.

3. Eligibility

Participation in the judo competition is open to athletes born in the years 2002 to 2004 who have adequate physical and technical training and are qualified II junior category and 4th KYU.

Weight categories:

**Under 46 kg, U 50 kg, U 55 kg, U 60 kg, U 66 kg, U 73 kg, U 81 kg, U 90 kg,
Over 90 kg.**

4. The Procedure of the Competition

- competition involves personal interest;
- there are three mats available for the competition;
- contestants should wear either white or blue gi jacket;
- any technique allowed by the rules can be used;
- a charitable contribution of 100 UAH is foreseen;
- *Appropriate footwear should be worn to the mat edge from the changing rooms.*

18⁰⁰ – 19⁰⁰ – weigh-ins;

24.03.2018 - Sports Complex «Olympia+»

8⁰⁰ – 9⁰⁰ - weigh-ins;

9⁰⁰ – 10⁰⁰ - draw;

11⁰⁰ – 11³⁰ - competition opening ceremony;

11³⁰ - competition start.

Upon the completion of previous fights, a final block will be held. Then winners and medalists will be awarded.

25-26.03.2018 – Sports School No.6

10⁰⁰-12⁰⁰ - Randori (par terre position, standing position);

17³⁰-19³⁰ - Randori (par terre position, standing position).

5. Management of the Competition

An organizing committee approved by Judo Federation Dnipro Region shall carry out the organization, arrangement and conduct of the competition.

6. Financing

Judo Federation Dnipro Region takes on the expenses related to the organization and conduct of the judo tournament. Contestants' accommodation and other expenses shall be borne by sending organizations.

7. Awards

Medalists are awarded with trophies, diplomas, and medals, whereas winners are awarded with valuable prizes.

8. Procedure for Sports Facilities Preparation

In accordance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated 18.12.1998 "On the procedure for the preparation of sports facilities and other specially designated sports, mass and cultural events":

- owners of sports facilities are responsible for the preparation of the premises;
- control over sports facilities preparation and security during the competition shall be carried out by a working committee made of persons responsible for the competition and owners of sports facilities;
- the sports facility owners shall submit to the working committee an Inspection Release Notice at least 4 hours prior the start of the competition;
- failure to carry out the requirements stipulated by this clause, which had become the reason for emergencies, lead to liability provided by the current Ukrainian legislation.

9. Applications

The application must be filled in XLS format and submitted prior to March 20, 2018 to ostroyx9090@gmail.com.

Registered applications certified by the doctor and the sending organization shall be submitted to the credential commission before a weigh-in. ID shall be presented during a weigh-in.
